
Japan Academic Network for Disaster Reduction

- This network aims for promoting interdisciplinary cooperation for disaster reduction and disaster restoration.






Representatives of 47 Academic Societies and members of Science Council of Japan, January 9, 2016

Disaster external force increases, such as earthquakes, volcanoes, heavy rains and typhoons. Now, we must prepare for next catastrophes!

Seismic activity of the Japanese archipelago is activated, Nankai Trough and Tokyo Metropolitan Inland Earthquakes are feared. In global climate change, there is a tendency that disasters occur severer and more frequently in the world.

For prevention and mitigation of disasters, many research fields are involved, such as earth observation, meteorology, earthquake, tsunami, oceanography, engineering, history, disaster prevention planning and emergency medical care. In academic world, specialization has been progressed and integration has been weakened. For protecting people's lives and the land from natural disasters, we need comprehensive platform beyond the boundaries. This network aims to deepen mutual understanding across different expertise.

[Activities record]_(We worked as 30 Academic Society Liaison Association)

We held 11 serial symposiums of 'How to protect people's lives and national land from huge disasters' from November 2011 to January 2016. Based on these activities, we presented Joint Statement of 30 Academic Societies "Proposal for Revision of Japanese Disaster Prevention and Reduction Policies" on May 10, 2012. We also published a special feature in "Trends in the Sciences" March 2013.


In the 10th symposium, we dedared "Joint Statement of 30 Disaster-Related Academic Societies of Japan, Global sharing of the findings from the Past Great Earthquake Disasters in Japan", and published the booklet of 30 academic societies' international activities and initiatives against the great earthquakes.

[History of establishment, Relationship with Science Council of Japan]

Great East Japan Earthquake occurred in March 11, 2011. The earthquake was exceeded our expectations and our science and engineering were not enough. After the Earthquake, the members of Science Council of Japan became founders and 24 academic societies (later 30) relevant to disaster management gathered and established "Academic Society Liaison Association Corresponding to the Great East Japan Earthquake" in May 2011.

On July 2015, Science Council of Japan established new committee for promoting interdisciplinary cooperation of disaster reduction and disaster restoration and strengthened to help our activities.

As the successor of this association, we established "Japan Academic Network for Disaster Reduction" on January 9th, 2016. This network targets not only earthquakes but also natural disasters in general.

Science Council of Japan and Japan Academic Network for Disaster Reduction will collaborate across academies to promote multidisciplinary research for disaster reduction in the world.
